**2012-2013**

1. Review of objectives

- 1.1 Additional English language support to weaker students and brighter students had largely been achieved through provision of extra grammar classes and oral practice sessions.
- 1.2 Teachers' workload on preparation of teaching materials had been relieved by teaching assistants' clerical support to English Language, History, Chinese History and Religious Education panels.
- 1.3 Enhancement programmes of religious formation activities, leadership training camps, potential development programmes for brighter senior form students, mediation skill training for prefects, adventure-based training camp for junior form students all boosted students' confidence, psychological well-being as well as the leadership skills.
